

# Front Entrance Concept Feedback 2014

1. **Paver walkway** from Pelican Bay Blvd, crossing our road, connecting to the pond.

2. **Signage** Remove north-most sign near Coco Bay. Replace sign located in front of the office with 2-sided sign at a 90 degree. This sign can be seen from either direction when traveling Pelican Bay Boulevard. Install 9 columns along the long landscaped boulevard to signify this area as belonging to "Pebble Creek". Both the sign and the columns will repeat paint and roof colors chosen for the buildings.

Comments:

3. **Updates to the landscaping** at the entry inside and outside the gate. Form hedges along the boulevard and remove or trim some trees along the boulevard. Two of the 6 Royal palms in the driveway median will remain. Other 4 will be used inside the front gate to form a feature area. (Palms are planted too close together.) Flower bed for color in front of the new sign. Inside the gate, a pergola/trellis installed over the paver walkway to display a colorful vine. Two garden areas with ground cover and colorful shrubs. Three small flowering trees. Three Royal palms transplanted here.

4. **Entry gates** Use the current gates, removing the "spears" on the top of those gates to give the gate a more Coastal Modern look (rather than Mediterranean). Paint a color that coordinates with any new building colors chosen by owners.
